

Brian O'Mahony is the Chief Executive and President of the European Haemophilia Consortium based in Brussels. He previously served as Chair of the Irish Haemophilia Society for 17 years and as President of the World Federation of Haemophilia establishing twinning and advocacy programmes in developing economies and his publications for include Monographs on Advocacy, Developing National Patient Organisations, Economics and Health Technology Assessments and a Guidebook on National Tender systems. His training work includes organising and facilitating workshops on Advocacy and Lobbying, and Strategic Planning. He has facilitated training courses for Health Ministries, Clinicians and patient organisations in many countries. His scientific publications include papers on prophylaxis, surveys of Haemophilia care in Europe, consensus papers on blood and plasma issues and papers on the economics of Haemophilia care.
